The Sub-Committee are tasked with the administration of umpire, observer, assessor & match referee appointments for all competitions as agreed annually.

Sub-Committee Structure

The Sub-Committee will be led by the Head of Umpire & Observer Appointments who will have been elected by the membership onto the CSMOA Extended Committee

The Sub-Committee will have additional members, as appointed by Head of Umpire & Observer Appointments, and approved by the Domestic Umpires Manager. These members will be delegated responsibilities for competitions as deemed necessary by the Chair.

Umpire Appointments Process

All matches within the auspices of CSMOA will be populated onto Who's the Umpire (WTU) prior to the commencement of the season (or during the season for adhoc requests & cup matches).

Match officials are required to maintain their availability using WTU. The system default is that match officials are **unavailable**.

Premier League Matches:

Matches within the Eastern & Western Premier Leagues (EPL & WPL) will be issued two weeks prior however, the selection of officials will have been released four-weekly with week 17 & 18 issued in a 2-week block.

Umpires are appointed to matches based on their Category & the Sub-Committee will work primarily from top to bottom in its appointments to league matches.

Championships & Lower League Matches:

Batches of league appointments for competitions below the Premierships will be issued fourweekly with week 17 & 18 of the league season issued separately. There is no requirement to issue a selection of officials' document.

Umpires are appointed to matches based on their Category & the Sub-Committee will work primarily from top to bottom in its appointments to league matches.

Local Cup Matches:

Local Cup Matches (i.e. Rowan Cup, Masterton) are the responsibility of the Appointments Officers.

National Cup Matches:

National Cup Matches (i.e. Scottish Cup, Challenge Cup) are the responsibility of the Head of Umpire Appointments, however, may be delegated to the Appointments Officers. Input should be sought from the Sub-Committee for appointments to these matches.

All Cup Final appointments will be discussed & agreed by the Sub-Committee. This will then be issued to the Domestic Umpires Manager for final approval. On approval, appointments will be issued to the match officials.

Scotland & Regional Youth Matches (Men's & Women's):

Scotland & Regional Youth Matches (i.e. Caley, East & West U14 & U16 matches) are the responsibility of the Head of Umpire Appointments. Appointments for these matches shall be agreed with the International & Regional Umpires Manager prior to issuing to match officials.

CS Senior Regional Matches (Men's' & Women's):

Senior Regional Matches (i.e. Senior Pro 50 & T20 Blitz) are the responsibility of the Head of Umpire Appointments. Appointments for these matches shall be discussed & agreed with the International & Regional Umpires Manager prior to issuing to match officials.

CS International Matches:

International Matches (i.e. ODIs & T20Is) are the responsibility of the International & Regional Umpires Manager. Appointments for these matches shall be agreed with the International & Regional Umpires Manager prior to issuing to match officials by the Head of Umpire Appointments.

University / Schools / Adhoc domestic club matches:

Several adhoc matches may require umpires to be appointed. These will on most occasions be handled by the Appointments Officers.

Once appointments are issued, match officials are required to accept or decline using the links provided in the automated email generated by WTU.

The Sub-Committee will keep records pertaining to the appointments as they deem necessary.

Domestic: Boundary & Colleague Observer Process

Boundary Observers are required to maintain their availability using WTU. The system default is that Boundary Observers are **unavailable**.

In liaison with the Head of Umpire Development, the appointment of Boundary & Colleague Observers will be made and issued in the same manner as the Umpire Appointments.

Observers may be appointed based on the development needs of the official(s), the stature of a match, in line with a match officials Personal Development Plan or for any other reason deemed appropriate.

International & Regional: Assessor & Match Referee Process

Assessors & Match Referees are required to maintain their availability using WTU. The system default is that these officials are **unavailable**.


In liaison with the International & Regional Umpires Manager, the appointment of Assessors or Match Referees will be made and issued in the same manner as the Umpire Appointments.

An Assessor or Match Referee <u>must</u> be appointed to all Senior Regional Matches. Otherwise, Assessors may be appointed based on the development needs of the official(s), the stature of a match, in line with a match officials Personal Development Plan or for any other reason deemed appropriate.

Category 5	A match official who is within probationary membership & or has joined via the Class Pathway. i.e., attended Stage One training.		
	A match official who may have the potential to meet the standards expected of a Category 3 or 4 Umpire, subject to demonstrating the requisite standards of performance & submission of their Personal Development Plan (PDP).		
Category	Associate members who have an interest in Match Officials.		
6	A match official who is largely in-active but seeks to retain their membership A match official who may largely umpire their own Club matches
